Government have approved various recommendations contained in the 4th Report of the 4th Administrative Reforms Commission – Personnel Reforms: Civil Service in Kerala, vide G.O. read above. Among these, Recommendation No.120 stipulates that, in order to reduce or minimise travel, official meetings and conferences shall be conducted through video conferencing.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accept Recommendation No.120 of the 4th Report of the 4th Administrative Reforms Commission and orders are hereby issued as follows:

1. Government meetings shall, by default, be conducted in online mode, especially for participants required to attend from distant locations.


