ORDER

Whereas, the Government are of opinion that an industrial dispute exists between the Administrator, Holy Cross Hospital, Kottiyam P.O, Kollam -691571 and the workers of the above referred establishment represented by the President, Private Hospital Employees Association Of Kerala(I.N.T.U.C) Reg.No. 02-18-1988, Mundaikkal, Kollam-691001 in respect of matters mentioned in the annexure to this order;

(2) And whereas, in the opinion of Government it is necessary to refer the said industrial dispute for adjudication;

(3) Now therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 10(1)(d) of the Industrial Disputes Act of 1947(Central Act XIV of 1947)the Government hereby direct that the said industrial dispute be referred for adjudication to the Industrial Tribunal, Kollam.The Industrial Tribunal will pass the award within a period of three months.
