ORDER

As per the Government Order read as 1st paper above, the Kerala State Spatial Data Infrastructure (KSDI) Project, under Kerala State IT Mission was transferred to Kerala State Remote Sensing & Environment Centre (KSREC). As per the said order, direction was issued to the Director, KSITM to transfer Rs.6 crore (Rupees Six Crore Only), received from Government of India as financial assistance under Part-II (PM Gatishakthi related expenditure) of "Scheme for Special Assistance to States for Capital Investment for 2022-23" from the Head of Account 4859-02-004-88(05) to the PSTSB account of the KSREC for the implementation of the Kerala G-Governance Platform (K-GIS). As per the Government Order read as 2nd paper above, the said amount has been transferred to the PSTSB account of KSREC for the implementation of the Kerala G-Governance Platform (K-GIS), subject to the condition that KSREC shall utilise this amount only after obtaining Administrative Sanction from the Planning and Economic Affairs Department.

2. The Director, KSREC as per letters read as 3rd paper above, submitted proposal amounting to Rupees Six Crores as detailed below and requested to

accord sanction for the implementation of Kerala G-Governance Platform (K-GIS) through KSREC. The Director, KSREC has also informed that manpower cost of Rupees One Crore per annum is required for implementing K-GIS and has requested to sanction this amount through Annual Plan Support. The Director, KSREC further clarified that at present KSREC can manage the project initiation with its existing staff, till sanction for additional manpower for Kerala G - Governance Platform (K-GIS) is obtained.
