ORDER

The Director, Scheduled Tribes Development Department as per the letter read above has submitted a proposal for Road protection work at Kurityottumala resettlement area in Kollam District at an estimated cost of ₹2,07,00,000 /- (Rupees Two crore Seven Lakh Only) to Government for placing before the State Level Working Group Committee.

(2) The State Level Working Group held on 26/04/2025 considered the proposal and recommended approval of the same.

(3) Government have accepted the recommendation of the State Level Working Group and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for the Project proposal for Road protection work at Kurityottumala resettlement area in Kollam District, as per the Estimate No. LSGD/CELSGD/EST/5703/2022_5_1_1(Edit Id :3), at an estimated

cost of ₹2,07,00,000 /- (Rupees Two crore Seven Lakh Only), subject to the following conditions:

- i. After completion of the project, the asset should be handed over to the concerned Local Self Government Institutions and is to be entered in their Asset Register.
- ii. After completion of the project, the boards displaying the name of Scheduled Tribes Development department should be installed for Public Information.
- iii. The Director, Scheduled Tribes Development Department should identify critical gap areas and should find out the possibility of a comprehensive master plan connecting the unconnected areas.
- iv. The scope of engaging MGNREGS workers should be explored wherever possible.
- v. The work should be completed within the Financial year.
- vi. The District Development Council should monitor the progress of the work on a monthly basis.
- vii. The Director, Scheduled Tribes Development Department also should monitor the progress of the project. If there is any delay, the Director shall take necessary steps to resolve the issues immediately. If the matter could not be resolved at the Director level, it should be immediately reported to the Government for intimation to the Secretary, Local Self Government Department.

(4) Expenditure in this regard will be met from the Head of Account 4225-02-283-97 Resettlement of landless tribals.
