ORDER

Government have accorded in-principle Administrative Sanction for an amount of ₹5,00,00,000 (Rupees Five Crore only) for the Construction of Cosmic Discovery Dome & Planetarium at Kannur under the Special Assistance to States for Capital Investment (SASCI) 2025-26 Scheme, entrusting the Public Works Department (PWD) as the implementing agency for the project as per the Government Order read as 1st paper above, .

2. Later, as per the Government Order read as 2nd above, Government have authorised additional expenditure to the tune of ₹.5,00,00,000/- (Rupees Five Crore only) under the head of account 2203-00-112-61-35-P-V of Kerala State Science & Technology Museum for providing fund towards Construction of Cosmic Discovery Dome & Planetarium, Kannur under SASCI 2025-26 Scheme.

3. In continuation to the orders read above, Government are pleased to accord sanction to release an amount of ₹5,00,00,000/- (Rupees Five Crore only) from the head of account 2203-00-112-61-35 to PSTSB account (799012700001438) of Kerala State Science & Technology Museum maintained at District Treasury, Thiruvananthapuram, for implementing the Construction of Cosmic Discovery Dome & Planetarium, Kannur as deposit work through the Public Works Department.

4. The Director, Kerala State Science & Technology Museum shall take timely steps to deposit the amount to the Public Works Department.

5. The Director, Kerala State Science & Technology Museum shall provide the necessary technical requirements, specifications, and detailed scope of work from their domain perspective to the Public Works Department for due consideration and execution of the project.

6. The Director, Kerala State Science & Technology Museum shall also take timely steps to regularise this additional expenditure through Re-appropriation of savings only within the Grant before the close of current financial year.
