<u>ORDER</u>

An amount of Rs.15,536/- Lakh has been provided in the State Budget 2024-25 for Police Department under 'Modernisation of Police Department' to implement various schemes/activities during 2024-25 under the following Heads of Account:

2. The State Police Chief submitted proposal as per letter read as 2nd paper above for approval of the Departmental Working Group, for different Schemes under the above heads of account, for a total amount of ₹5000 Lakh (by deducting the committed expenditure of the previous year's Rs.1960.272 lakh from total outlay of Rs.6971 lakh). The amount

of ₹1960.272 lakh earmarked for previous year's committed expenditure are sanctioned to be expended from current year's FY as per the Government Order read as 1st paper above. This amount has been kept apart for each scheme accordingly.

3.The Departmental Working Group meeting held on 06.08.2024 considered the proposal furnished by the State Police Chief and approved the same as detailed below with certain conditions.

3. Government have examined the proposals furnished by the State Police Chief and the decisions taken by the Departmental Working Group and also the Technical Advisory Committee of Electronics & Information Technology in detail and are pleased to accord administrative sanction for a total amount of **Rs.5152.875 Lakhs (Rupees Five Thousand One Hundred and Fifty Two Lakhs Eighty Seven Thousand and Five Hundred Only)** under the respective Heads of Account under Modernisation of Police Department as agreed by the Working Group and as detailed above subject to the following conditions*.

4. Government in consideration of phasing out the expenditure in view of resources mobilization in sequential interval mode in the financial year, accords financial sanction for the schemes as per the **Annexure**, as first phase.

(i) The expenditure and the process for procurement of goods, works and services or any other item as expenditure can be started only for those items approved for financial sanction.

(ii) There shall not be the requirement of subsequent Administrative Sanction, when higher level of financial sanction will be accorded in the current financial year.

(iii) Financial sanction is also accorded for the items which has the mandatory remained expenditure, not covered under financial sanction now, but will be required to make the project functional.

*General Conditions:

a) All relevant rules and procedures in force shall scrupulously be followed.
b) The State Police Chief can issue Administrative Sanction to the Schemes which are ongoing/continuing (not new schemes) and within his delegated financial powers. In every Administrative Sanction issued, the details of the officer who is implementing the scheme, officer who is monitoring the progress and scheduled date of completion of the project/scheme are to be included. Also the The State Police Chief has to publish the weekly progress of the scheme/project in the website of the Department on a weekly basis.

c) The State Police Chief shall ensure that the Implementing Officer and the Monitoring Officer related with each scheme/projects works effectively to complete the project/scheme before the scheduled date of completion under prior intimation to Government.

d) The name and designation of designated officer for each scheme should be recorded and publish the weekly progress of the project in the website.

e) The order in GO (P) No.188/2018/Fin dated 07/12/2018 shall be strictly followed wherever it is applicable especially in the case of continuing schemes/multiyear projects.

f) Committed expenditure if any pertaining to the previous financial year shall be met from the current year budget provision subject to the concurrence of Finance Department.

g) Manpower, Vehicle purchase, vehicle hiring, fixing of remuneration and

purchase of furniture shall be done with the concurrence of Finance Department separately.

h) All purchase shall be done through GeM Portal in accordance with the existing rules and regulations of Store Purchase Department, E & IT Department & PWD.

i) Year of Completion shall be specified for Multi Year Projects (MYP).

j) Expenditure sanction for Multi Year Projects (MYP) will be subject to the allocation of fund in the current year's Budget.

k) Hiring of vehicle/man power shall be done only with the consent of Finance Department.

1) Accredited agencies shall be selected for the implementation of the projects.

m) Implementing agency shall be selected well in advance.

n) Purchase Rules as per Store Purchase Manual shall be followed.
