ORDER

State Executive Committee Meeting held on 31/01/2025, has approved the norms of assistance to the victims of Human Wildlife conflict from SDRF and Forest department. The culling and burial of notified wild pests such as wild pigs is included in the Item 3(b) of the norms. The problematic wild pigs and pests notified by Forests & Wildlife Department which cause threat to life, property and agriculture in human habitations are killed by authorized shooters assigned by the local self-governments concerned.

In this regard, Government are pleased to sanction the following financial assistance from SDRF regarding the culling and burial of notified wild pests including wild pigs.

- Honorarium for a shooter per animal killed is ₹1500/-
- Financial assistance for animal carcasses burial shall be ₹2000/-

The expenditure in this regard shall be certified by concerned Panchayath Secretary. The actual amount limiting to ₹1,00,000 per LSG institution per financial year will be reimbursed by DDMA to the concerned Local Self Government.
