**ORDER**

As per the Government Order read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above, sanction was accorded for the establishment of the 'Cyber Police Division' in the State, in order to address the complexities of Cyber Challenges. For the functioning of Cyber Police Division, posts were sanctioned by way of redeployment, creation of posts, by abolishing vacant technical posts and also redundant posts in erstwhile District Armed Reserve, in order to compensate the financial commitment involved in the creation of posts. Accordingly for the functioning of Cyber Police Division, 110 technical Police Constable Posts including 9 Blacksmith PC posts were abolished, in which 1 post was belonging to Mounted Police Unit in Thiruvananthapuram district .

2. The State Police Chief as per the letter read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above has reported that the post of Blacksmith PC in Mounted Police Unit in Thiruvananthapuram district, is inevitable for the operation of the Mounted Police Unit, since the production and maintenance of horseshoes is the responsibility of that post . Hence, the State Police Chief has recommended to create a post of Blacksmith Police Constable in Mounted Police Unit of Thiruvananthapuram City by redeployment or shifting of one Blacksmith PC post from KAP IV Battalion, which became vacant on 01.03.2025.

3. Government have examined the mater in detail and are pleased to shift one post of Black Smith from KAP IV battalion to Mounted Police Unit , Thiruvananthapuram on condition that the post in KAP IV Battalion was not vacant for the last one year.
