### ORDER

The State Police Chief, as per letter read as 2nd paper above, has informed that the Bureau of Police Research & Development (BPR&D) conveyed that the Micro Mission:05 of BPR&D National Police Mission had developed a project 'Automation of Weapon Licencing System' which is aimed to prepare a system based mechanism to issue, record, monitor and manage arms/ammunition licences efficiently and effectively and they have also shared a project document of the same and requested to consider the project for implementation in the State. After studying the proposal, the State Police Chief has submitted their findings and also informed that the approximate financial commitment for implementing the project has been analyzed for components such as Software development, Hardware, Biometric devices etc. The State Police Chief has also requested to take necessary action to implement the proposal.

2) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction to the State Police Chief for inviting the RFP as per the workplan from BPR&D.

3)The State Police Chief shall submit the estimated financial commitment for implementation of the project, along with the proposed revenue model for running the project in a self sustainable mode, based on the proposals received from potential firms.

4) The State Police Chief is also directed to explore the scope and extent of Central funding under ASUMP scheme in proper consultation with the Government of India and to submit a report to the Government.
