ORDER

As per the Government Order, read as 1st paper above, Government have set up an 'Asset Maintenance Fund Scheme, 2009' in view of the erstwhile Asset Renewal Fund, consequent to the declaration in the Budget Speech, 2009-10. The objective of the scheme is to maintain the existing assets of Government but not creation of Assets. In the Government Order read as 2nd paper above, a State Level Committee, under the chairmanship of the Additional Chief Secretary (Finance) was constituted for the effective administration of the Fund.

2. As per reference read as 5th paper above, the Director of Medical Education has forwarded the detailed estimate prepared by Public

Works Department for carrying out the work - Urgent Rectification of the Existing Roof and Maintenance Works at the South Wing of the Old Administrative Block at Government T.D. Medical College, Alappuzha and requested to accord Administrative Sanction for the same under Asset Maintenance Fund Scheme.

3. The State Level Committee on Asset Maintenance Fund, in its meeting held on 28.02.2026 approved the above works, as detailed in the minutes read above.

4. Government have examined the proposal in detail. Accordingly, **Administrative Sanction** is hereby accorded for carrying out the '**Urgent Rectification of the Existing Roof and Maintenance Works at the South Wing of the Old Administrative Block at Government T.D. Medical College, Alappuzha**', under Asset Maintenance Fund Scheme, for a total amount of ₹ 1,04,21,000/- (**Rupees One Crore Four Lakh and Twenty One Thousand Only**), by meeting the expenditure under the head of account '**2210-05-105-61(NP)-Maintenance of Assets in the Department of Medical Education - Expenditure Met Out of Asset Maintenance Fund**', subject to the condition that the works shall be executed in line with the existing DSR guidelines and as per the relevant Government Orders related to the subject matter.

5. The sanctioned works shall be carried out through Public Works Department represented by the concerned Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings Division), Alappuzha who is designated as the implementing officer for the work. The work shall be executed within a time period of one year.

6. The expenditure shall be limited to the amount sanctioned. The amount sanctioned shall be utilised only for renovation/maintenance of existing assets, as stipulated in the Government Orders read as 1st to 3rd papers above and Circular read as 4th paper above. All works shall be done in a transparent manner, tender and other stipulated formalities shall be followed wherever necessary with respect to civil works and purchase of equipment or articles. Purchase of new assets/equipment of movable or immovable nature and construction of new buildings, compound walls extraneous to the maintenance of existing assets will not be eligible for assistance under AMF.

7. The progress of the work shall be monitored by the Director of Medical Education. The implementing officer i.e. the Executive Engineer, PWD shall furnish action taken report once in every three months to Government in the Finance (Planning B) Department through

the Director of Medical Education. Also the utilisation certificate duly countersigned by the Head of the Department concerned shall be submitted to Government in the Finance (Planning - B) Department, after completion of the work. The Director of Medical Education shall ensure that there would not be any duplication of receiving funds for the same purposes.
