ORDER

The XVth Finance Commission of India has recommended an amount of ₹586.95 crore as grant-in-aid for Health Sector to be channelized through Local Governments for the year 2023-24. Out of this, ₹116.7213 crore for 4 schemes were released to the state in 2024-25

2) The Director, FCD vide, letter read as 6th paper above, has conveyed the release of Health Sector Grant for the scheme – 'Support to Diagnostic Infrastructure in the primary health care facilities of the PHCs' under XVth Finance Commission amounting to ₹54.9450 crore for the year 2023-24. It has been requested to transfer the grant-in-aid directly to the Department concerned authorized by the State Level Committee for procurement under the component – Support to Diagnostic Infrastructure in the primary health care facilities of the PHCs.

- 3) As per Govt order read as 5th paper above, the method of transfer of Health Sector Grant has been modified in accordance with the Govt of India guidelines.
- 4) Government, after having examined the matter in detail, are pleased to transfer an amount of ₹54,94,50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Four crore Ninety Four lakh Fifty Thousand only) as Health Sector Grant scheme- 'Support to Diagnostic Infrastructure in the primary health care facilities of the PHCs' under 15th Finance Commission released by Govt of India on 28/03/2025 for the year 2023-24 to the LSG (Rural)Department.
- 5) The Under Secretary, Finance (Accounts) Department is authorized to transfer credit the amounts from the head of account concerned to the Bank accounts of Finance Department opened for Health Grants to Local Governments under Finance Commission Award and therefrom to the Bank account of the Department concerned on or before 10/04/2025 as detailed below:
