ORDER

As per the letter read as 1st paper above, the Managing Director, Kerala Automobiles Limited (KAL) has requested Government sanction to utilise vacant workspace available in the company premises for conducting training programmes under PM Vishwakarma Project, as proposed by M/s Hindusthan Latex Family Planning Promotion Trust (HLFPPT), an approved agency for implementing the Project.

2) Being a revenue generating proposal and considering the present financial condition of KAL, the Board for Public Sector Transformation (BPT), as per the letter read as 2nd paper above, has recommended the proposal and requested to accord sanction for utilising the earmarked space, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors and executing an agreement .

3) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction to Kerala Automobiles Limited to proceed with the proposal to utilise the spareable workspace available at company premises for conducting training programmes under PM Vishwakarma Project, subject to the approval of Board of Directors and subject to execution of an agreement between KAL and M/s HLFPPT, clearly defining terms and conditions, including maximum extent of space that can be spared for the purpose,

payment conditions, roles and responsibilities of KAL etc, duly approved by Board of Directors of KAL.

4)The agreement shall explicitly stipulated that, in the absence of training activities, the space shall be utilised by KAL for its operational requirements after prior intimation to HLPPT.

5) The draft of the agreement shall be furnished to the Government, for vetting.
