ORDER

Government have accorded administrative sanction for the Digitization of Wireless Communication (DMR Tier II) in 5 Districts, under the Scheme 'Assistance to States and UTs for Modernisation of Police (ASUMP)' 2025-26 (State Share), as per Government Order read as 1st paper above. An amount of Rs.2350 Lakh has been earmarked under the said scheme for the implementation of Digitization of Wireless Communication in five districts viz, Thiruvananthapuram Rural, Kollam City, Kollam Rural, Palakkad and Malappuram. The specification committee headed by DySP(C&T), Telecommunication & Technology, after a detailed study, has recommended that the implementation may be carried out by grouping the districts into two geographically adjacent clusters i.e, Southern Cluster (Thiruvananthapuram Rural, Kollam City& Kollam Rural) and Northern Cluster (Palakkad and Malappuram). Hence, two separate tender procedures were initiated for the implementation of DMR Tier II project for the five districts as Southern Cluster and Northern Cluster.

2) The State Police Chief, as per letter read as 2nd paper above, has requested to convene Departmental Purchase Committee for considering the proposal and to accord purchase sanction for the implementation of DMR Tier II project for the Southern Cluster (Thiruvananthapuram

Rural, Kollam City &Kollam Rural) to the firm M/s.Arya Communications Electronics Services Pvt Ltd, who had quoted the lowest rate, which is within the estimate.

3) The Departmental Purchase Committee meeting held on 03.02.2026, accepted the proposal of the State Police Chief and decided to accord purchase sanction for the implementation of DMR Tier II project for the Southern Cluster (Thiruvananthapuram Rural, Kollam City & Kollam Rural) to the L1 firm M/s.Arya Communications Electronics Services Pvt Ltd. for an amount of Rs.13,13,29,500/-.

4) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord purchase sanction for the implementation of DMR Tier II project in Thiruvananthapuram Rural, Kollam City &Kollam Rural (Southern Cluster), to the firm M/s.Arya Communications Electronics Services Pvt Ltd, at a total cost of Rs.13,13,29,500/-(Rupees Thirteen Crore Thirteen Lakh Twenty Nine Thousand and Five Hundred only), by meeting the expenditure from the funds sanctioned under the ASUMP Scheme (State Share) for the year 2025-26, subject to observance of relevant rules, regulations and procedural formalities in this regard.
