<u>ORDER</u>

As per orders read as 1st to 5th paper above, fund has been sanctioned to various projects of Fomil under h/a- 2851-00-106-62.As per letter read as 6th paper above, the Director of Coir Development reported that an amount of Rs.1,82,19,492/ - (Rs One Crore Eighty Two lakh Nineteen Thousand Four Hundred and Ninety Two Only) released under h/a- 2851-00-106-62 to the PSTSB account of FOMIL for various projects was resumed on 31.3.2021 and requested to reallocate the same.
