Home Department - Police Department – Purchase of 05 Nos of Trooper horses from the Remount Veterinary Services (RVS), Indian Army - Administrative Sanction accorded - Orders issued.

ORDER

The State Police Chief, as per letter read as 2nd paper above, has reported that the Mounted Police Unit is currently facing an acute shortage of serviceable horses required for daily mounted patrols, law and order duties, and ceremonial functions. It has also been reported that although sanction was accorded earlier for procuring 8 horses vide Government Order read as 1st paper above, only 3 could be purchased since the horses were not available with the RVS during that financial year, and the allotted funds were remitted back. The Remount Veterinary Services (RVS), Indian Army has now informed that they are in a position to supply 5 Nos.of Trooper A trained horses in January 2026. Therefore the State Police Chief has requested to accord administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.42,00,000/- for the procurement of 5 Trooper A Horses from RVS, Indian Army by meeting the expenditure under the head of account 2055-109-99-34-3 .

2) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord administrative sanction for the purchase of five horses from RVS, Indian Army for an amount of Rs.42,00,000/- (Rupees Forty Two Lakhs Only) by meeting the expenditure under the head of account 2055-00-109-99-00-34-03 (NV), subject to the condition that the State Police Chief should reconfirm that only three horses have been purchased so far against the Administrative Sanction accorded for the purchase of eight horses vide Government Order read as 1st paper above.
