ORDER

Whereas, the Government are of opinion that an industrial dispute exists between the Director, Amala Institutes of Medical Sciences, Amala Nagar P.O, Thrissur - 680 555 and the employees of the above referred establishment represented by the General Secretary, Thrissur District Private Hospital Workers Association (CITU), Machingal Lane, Thrissur - 680 001 in respect of matters mentioned in the annexure to this order;

And whereas, in the opinion of Government it is necessary to refer the said industrial dispute for adjudication;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 10(1) (d) of the Industrial Disputes Act of 1947 (Central Act XIV of 1947) the Government hereby direct that the said industrial dispute be referred for adjudication to the Industrial Tribunal, Thrissur. The Industrial Tribunal will pass the award within a period of three months.
