ORDER

Government, vide GO read as Paper 1st above, accorded Administrative Sanction for the work "GENERAL-FDR-2024- 25-Providing BM BC To Kulapully Eliapetta Road B/w Ch: 9/000 to 14/245" in Shornur LAC for an amount of Rs.500 lakhs. Then the Chief Engineer has reported that since the road stretch was handed over for JJM pipe laying works, it is not possible to carry out the work for the entire length and requested to reduce the scope of the work. Besides, the Chief Engineer has submitted a proposal for Revised Administrative Sanction for the work "GENERAL - FDR Providing BM BC to Kulapully Eliapetta Road km 09/000 to 12/000-In shornur LAC-General Civil Work" for an amount of Rs.500 Lakh.

2) Government have examined the matter in detail and are

pleased to accord Revised Administrative Sanction with Nomenclature change for the work "FDR providing BM BC to Kulappully Eliapetta Road km 09/000 to 12/000 In Shornur LAC - General Civil Work" for an amount of Rs.500 Lakh (Rupees Five Crore only) under the head of account 3054-03-337-96-Flood Damage Repairs" subject to the following conditions;

- 1) The chainages of work shall be ascertained by the TS authority.
- 2) TS Authority shall ensure that there is no duplication between any works with the current proposal.
- 3) The numerical accuracy of the provisions shall be ensured by the TS authority.
- 4) Shoulder concreting shall be limited to essential locations only. In case, it is proposed over KWA pipe line, the possibility of interlocking tiles of adequate capacity shall be explored.
- 5) Stability of the culverts shall be ensured by the TS authority
- 6) Numerical accuracy, provisions, quantities and rates shall be verified and confirmed by the TS authority.
