ORDER

The State Police Chief as per letter read as 3rd paper above has informed that the Police Department (KLSSM09) had opened State Government (SG) drawing accounts in the Reserve Bank and has successfully mapped the SG account number in the relevant module on the PFMS portal.

2) Additionally, the scheme configuration for “ASUMP (MAIN PLAN) - KL 266”& "ASUMP HM Contingency Reserve - KL 401" had also been completed in the SPARSH module and both the schemes were approved by the Programme Division, MHA.

3) The Ministry of Home Affairs as per letter read as 2nd paper above has informed that, the Mother Sanction of Rs.22,21,00,000/- under the Scheme of "Assistance to States and UTs for Modernisation of Police (ASUMP)" under the Umbrella Scheme of Modernisation of Police Forces in the current financial year 2025-26 in respect of the Government of Kerala has been created with the approval of the Competent Authority subject to certain conditions. Therefore the State Police Chief, as per letter read as 3rd paper above has requested to allocate/release the “Mother Sanction” of total amount of Rs.37.02 Crore (Rs.22.21 Crore Central Share + Rs.14.81 Crore State Share) to the Kerala Police Department for the

"Assistance to States and UTs for Modernisation of Police (ASUMP)" 2025-2026 scheme under the head of account "2055-00-115-99-(02)State Share" to ensure the prompt implementation through SNA SPARSH.

4) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to release an amount Rs.37,02,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Seven Crore Two Lakh Only) under the head of account 2055-00-115-99-02-00-00-P-V" (Central share of Rs.22.21 Crore and corresponding State Share of Rs.14.81 Crore) for the implementation of the scheme "Assistance to States and UTs for Modernisation of Police" through SNA SPARSH.

5) An amount of Rs. 35,44,70,000/- (Rupees Thirty Five Crore Forty Four Lakh Seventy Thousand Only) is additionally authorized under the head of account 2055-00-115-99-02-00-00-P-V, as per the Government order read as 4th paper above for the said purpose.

6) The State Police Chief shall follow the conditions stipulated below while implementing the scheme:

i) The state Police Chief shall expedite utilization of funds as per the Scheme norms/guidelines for implementation of the Approved Action Plan of the State for the FY 2025-26.

ii) All the terms and conditions stipulated in the guidelines of this scheme will be strictly adhered to. Further, the prescribed administrative and financial rules/ regulations, procedure of budgeting, accounting internal control, auditing shall also be strictly adhered to.

iii) The procedure for release of funds under the centrally sponsored schemes and monitoring utilization of the funds released, as circulated by Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance from time to time, shall be fully complied with.

iv) Furthermore, the State Police Chief shall comply with the instructions issued by the Ministry of Finance vide OM No.1 (27)/PFMS/2020 dated 13th July, 2023, specifically para 3(v) which states that "upon on-boarding of a scheme onto SNA-SPARSH platform, the State Government shall close all the SNA accounts pertaining to the scheme and return the Central share of unspent balance lying in the SNA accounts to the Consolidated Fund of India (CFI). Similarly, the State share of unspent balance in the SNA accounts should be returned to the Consolidated Fund of the State.

Further, the Central share under the scheme lying in State treasury should also be returned to the CFI."

v) The SNA, DDO and Scheme Manager shall adhere to the guidelines and instructions issued by the Central Ministry and the State Government from time to time.
