ORDER

As per guidelines issued in the Government Order read as 1st paper above, for availing assistance from Kerala Infrastructure Investment Fund Board (KIIFB), the Administrative Department should identify Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) for executing the projects before according in-principle approval to the projects proposed for implementation under KIIFB.

2) As per the G.O read as 2nd paper above, the KSEBL was engaged as SPV for the project " Development of Taluk Hospital,

Munnar". As per G.O read as 3rd paper above, the 01.9818 hectare of land in Survey No.20/1 pt in Kannan Devan Hills village, was handed over to DHS for the development of Multi Speciality Hospital at Munnar, with the ownership and control of the said land vested in Revenue Department . Subsequently, as per letter read as 4th paper above, the KSEBL requested to exempt them from implementation of the project "Development of Taluk Hospital, Munnar" due to man power constraints and financial liabilities of KSEBL .As per the G.O read as 5th paper above, the Revenue Department extended the time limit for starting the construction activities for the development of Taluk Hospital, Munnar for a further period of one year from 8-5-2025. As per letter read as 6th paper above, the Director of Health Services has requested to engage another SPV for the speedy implementation of the project.

3) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to engage HITES as the Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) for the development of Taluk Hospital, Munnar in the land allocated vide G.O read as 3rd paper above. The SPV shall submit Detailed Project Report within one month positively.
