ORDER

As per the letter read as 1st paper above, The Kerala State Disaster Management Authority (KSDMA) has forwarded a proposal submitted by the District Collector, Wayanad, for establishing a comprehensive disaster risk monitoring system in the district. Wayanad, being one of the most disaster-prone districts in the State due to its steep terrain and high rainfall variability, is highly vulnerable to landslides, flash floods, and other extreme weather events. The proposed project aims to strengthen real-time monitoring systems and enable timely and accurate early warning dissemination and thereby improving disaster preparedness and response capability. It will also support scientific data collection and transmission, enabling Government departments, local self-governments, and other stakeholders to take informed preventive and response actions.

2. A detailed project proposal with an estimated cost of ₹3,93,80,000/- (Rupees Three Crore Ninety-Three Lakh Eighty Thousand only) has been submitted. The proposal was placed before the SDMF Appraisal Committee, which has approved and recommended it for the consideration by the State Executive Committee (SEC). The

Committee has further decided that, after the project period, KSDMA will support Wayanad DDMA with additional human resources—one Software Developer, one Field Assistant, and one Meteorologist—for continued operation and utilization of the system.

3.The matter was placed before the State Executive Committee meeting held on 01.06.2026 and the committee recommended the proposal for establishing a District-wide disaster risk monitoring system in Wayanad district for an amount of ₹3,93,80,000/- (Rupees Three Crore Ninety-Three Lakh Eighty Thousand only).

4. The Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to sanction an amount of ₹3,93,80,000/- (Rupees Three Crore Ninety-Three Lakh Eighty Thousand only) from the Head of Account "2245-07-101-99 SDMF Structural Mitigation Measures" for the establishing a District-wide disaster risk monitoring system in Wayanad District. The sanctioned amount shall be released to the District Collector, Wayanad for the implementation of the project.

5. The Finance Officer, Disaster Management Department, shall take necessary action to transfer the sanctioned amount from the State Disaster Mitigation Fund (SDMF) to the District Collector, Wayanad.

6.The amount shall be utilized from the current year's Budget Provision.
