ORDER

The Director of Handloom & Textiles, as per the letter read above, has submitted a proposal for Modernisation of K.Karunakaran Memorial Co-operative Spinning Mills Ltd, under Comprehensive Revival Scheme for Co-operative Spinning Mills under TEXTFED, for an amount of Rs.15 Lakh. It is reported that the Spinning mills in the State are proposed to be revived in the areas including that of raw material front, modernisation, production, diversification and development of quality products. It is also reported that a financial support is needed for modernization of K.Karunakaran Memorial Co-operative Spinning Mills. The expected outcome of the proposed project includes enhance productivity, reduce production costs, improve yarn quality and compete effectively in both domestic and international textile markets.

2. There is a Budget provision of Rs.700 Lakh for the year 2026-2027 under the head of account 6851-00-109-74-01(P) for the scheme 'Comprehensive Revival Scheme for Co-operative Spinning Mills'. The Director of Handloom and Textiles has requested to sanction an amount of Rs.15 Lakh for the proposal for Modernisation of K.Karunakaran Memorial Co-operative Spinning Mills under Comprehensive Revival Scheme for Co-operative Spinning Mills (under TEXTFED) from the h/a 6851-00-109-74-01(P).
