<u>ORDER</u>

As per Government Order read above, Government had sanctioned the sale of 100% shareholding of IL&FS Transportation Network Limited (ITNL) in Karyavattom Sports Facilities Limited. However, on detailed scrutiny, it is found that the aforesaid Government Order was issued without considering the Model Code of Conduct (MCC) that was in force in connection with election to Kerala Legislative Assembly 2021. Also, this being a policy matter, it was mandatory to obtain the approval of the Minister concerned or the Council of Ministers. It is seen that the file dealing with the subject matter of such important nature was not seen by the Hon'ble Minister, Sports thus violating the existing procedures making the Government order null and void ab initio.

Government have examined the matter in detail and further order that the Government Order read above stands cancelled on account of the reasons stated above.
