ORDER

Government had accorded administrative sanction for the partial modernisation of Prabhuram Mills, a unit of KSTC for an amount of Rs.878.36 Lakh, limiting the release to Rs.549.79 Lakh during 2025-26 as per the Government Order read as 1st paper above. However no amount was released during the year.

2) There is a Budget provision of Rs.1486 Lakh for the financial year 2026-27 under the head of account 6860-01-190-95 for modernisation of all units of Kerala State Textile Corporation Ltd. The Executive Chairman, BPT as per letter read as 2nd paper above has requested to re-validate the administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.500 Lakh for partial modernisation of Prabhuram Mills, a unit of Kerala State Textile Corporation Ltd from the funds provided under the head of account of 6860-01-190-95 of Kerala State Textile Corporation Ltd.

3) As first phase, during 2026-27 modernization of ring frame by replacing 14 old frames of 6184 Spindles with 4 new technology ring

frames of total 3,648 ring spindles is proposed along with humidification plant & supply duct. The financial outlay for the proposal is as detailed below.
