ORDER

As per the Government Order read as 1st above, sanction was accorded for the creation of one post of Network Engineer, two posts of Network Administrator, and one post of Network Technician on a temporary basis through the Public Works Department for the management and maintenance of the network system in the High Court of Kerala. Subsequently, the said temporary posts were extended for a further period of one year with effect from 30.05.2024, as per the Government Order read as 2nd above, and again for a further period of one year with effect from 30.05.2025, as per the Government Order read as 3rd above.

2. The Registrar (Computerisation)-cum-Director (IT), High Court of Kerala, vide reference 4th read above, has informed that the services of the aforesaid technical personnel were essential for the effective management, maintenance, and uninterrupted operation of the High Court's network and Data Centre. It has also been reported that in view of the increasing dependence on digital infrastructure and the expanding scope of network operations, retention of the said technical personnel was indispensable. The Registrar has also informed that the Hon'ble Chief Justice has been pleased to order provisional continuation of the engagement of the said

technical personnel, pending administrative sanction from the Government. Accordingly, the Registrar (Computerisation)-cum Director(IT) has requested Government to accord sanction for continuation of the above four temporary technical posts for a further period of one year with effect from 30.05.2026, as the existing term was due to expire on 29.05.2026.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord sanction for the continuation of the four temporary technical posts namely, one Network Engineer, two Network Administrators, and one Network Technician through the Public Works Department, for a further period of one year with effect from 30.05.2026, by meeting the expenditure from the Head of Account "2014-00-800-79-VP – "Modernization of High Court & Subordinate Courts", subject to the condition that approval/ratification of the Working Group shall be obtained for incurring expenditure towards the remuneration of the said technical personnel.
