ORDER

As per the letter read above the State Police Chief has informed that the Department of Administrative Reforms & Public Grievances (DARPG), Government of India, had invited proposals from States and Union Territories under the "State Collaboration Initiatives Scheme 2025-26" for innovative and citizen-centric projects. In response, the Kerala Police Department submitted a proposal titled "Pol-Blood Project" with the ambitious objective of achieving 100% voluntary blood donation in Kerala by 2028.

A crucial point raised by the Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances, which requires immediate attention, is the need for clarification as to whether the Government of Kerala has authorized the Kerala Police to implement the Pol-Blood Project at the State level. This formal authorization is essential to enable them to formally communicate the State's clearance to the Department of Administrative Reforms & Public Grievances and secure the financial assistance being considered.
