The Director, Industries& Commerce, Thiruvananthapuram as per letter read as 1st paper above forwarded a project proposal for conducting training & upgrading the infrastructural facility of common facility service centre at Kottamom unit of KELPALM under the Scheme 'Establishment of Common Facility Service Centres for Handicrafts' for an amount of ₹12.5 Lakh from the current year's(2025-26) budget provision under the H/A 2851-00-104-86-P, for administrative sanction, as detailed below:

An amount of Rs.50 Lakh has been provided for development and promotion of new designs, establishment and modernization of CFSCs of SURABHI, KADCO, HDCK and KELPALM under the Head of Account '2851-00-104-86-P' in the current year's (2025-26) budget provision. The project involves conducting training and upgrading the infrastructural facilities of the CFSC at the Kottamom unit of KELPALM.

The Working Group Meeting of Industries Department held on 30.04.2025 considered the above project proposal and recommended to accord Administrative Sanction for the implementation of the project, at a total estimated cost of ₹12.5 Lakh (Twelve Lakh and Fifty Thousand Rupees only) under the H/A-2851-00-104-86 (P) from the current year's budget provision.
