The Director of Industries & Commerce, Thiruvananthapuram, as per the letter read as the 1st paper above, forwarded a project proposal from the Kerala Artisans Development Corporation (KADCO) for Modernization and Diversification of CFSC for coconut timbers wood production under the scheme " under the scheme "Establishment of Common Facility Service Centres for Handicrafts", seeking administrative sanction. for an amount of ₹12.5 Lakh from the current year's (2025-26) budget provision under the Head of Account 2851-00-104-86-P. The details are as follows:

2. An amount of ₹50 Lakh has been provided in the 2025-26

budget under the Head of Account 2851-00-104-86-P for the development and promotion of new designs, and the establishment and modernization of CFSCs under SURABHI, KADCO, HDCK, and KELPALM..

3. The project aims to modernize the existing CFSC to convert it into a centre for producing value-added products using coconut timber (കെങ്ങിൻ തടി). The project also envisions supporting artisans through research-based technical guidance on product development using coconut wood. The total financial outlay of the project is ₹23,48,300/- as detailed in the proposal submitted by the Corporation. Due to current budgetary constraints, KADCO has requested an initial sanction of ₹12.5 Lakh to begin the project implementation.

4. The Working Group Meeting of the Industries Department held on 30.04.2025 considered the above proposal and recommended for according administrative sanction for the implementation of the project at a total estimated cost of ₹12.5 Lakh (Rupees Twelve Lakh Fifty Thousand only), under the Head of Account 2851-00-104-86-P, from the current year's budget provision.

5. In pursuance of the above, Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord administrative sanction for Modernization and Diversification of the Common Facility Service Centre (CFSC) for Coconut Timber Wood Production by KADCO, under the scheme "Establishment of Common Facility Service Centres for Handicrafts" for an amount of ₹12.5 Lakh (Rupees Twelve Lakh Fifty Thousand only) from the Plan Fund, limiting the expenditure to the current year's (2025-26) budget provision under the Head of Account 2851-00-104-86-P.

5. The Managing Director, Kerala Artisans Development Corporation (KADCO), shall forward the proposal for release of funds at the appropriate time.
