ORDER

The Chief Engineer, PWD Roads Division, Thiruvananthapuram vide letter read as above has requested to accord Administrative Sanction for the work - GENERAL-Budget work 2025-26- Improvements to various connectivity roads of Municipality and different panchayats under Kayamkulam LAC- General Civil Work - for a total amount of Rs. 500.00 lakh, under the h/a 5054-04-337-97 - ODR.

2. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for the work - "Budget work 2025-26- Improvements to various connectivity roads of Municipality and different Panchayats under Kayamkulam LAC" for a total amount of Rs. 500.00 lakh, under the h/a 5054-04-101-99 - MDR subject to the following conditions :

- 1) The scarified or dismantled pavement layers shall be re-used as sub base or at shoulders with proper compaction.
- 2) The provision for shoulder concrete, berm concrete, irish drain, etc. shall be allowed for shoulder protection in gradients & curves only and width of the same shall be limited to 50 cm.

- 3) The TS authority shall ensure that the design of retaining wall is carried out in compliance with the directions issued in the prevailing CTE circulars.
- 4) Proper account of re-usable materials obtained from dismantling items of work if any, shall be ensured without causing loss to state exchequer.
- 5) Defect liability period of the proposed road reach shall be ensured. Also, duplication of proposals under different schemes for the same reach may be avoided.
- 6) The correctness of the rates adopted for observed datas included in the estimates and the working chainages shall be ensured by the TS authority.
