**ORDER**

As per the Government order read as 1st paper above, Sri.Muhammed Ibrahim was appointed as the President, Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Kollam on the basis of a selection process conducted by Selection Committee constituted for the purpose as per the Consumer Protection Act, 1986 and Kerala Consumer Protection Rules 2005. He worked as the President, CDRC, Kollam from 28-12- 2017 to 27-12-2022. As per rule 15(1) (c) of the Kerala Consumer Protection Rules, 2005, existing then, he was eligible for the last pay drawn in the scale of pay of the District Judge plus allowances attached thereto, less the amount of pension including dearness relief to which he is entitled to.

2) Earlier Government have clarified that after the date of his superannuation, the petitioner is eligible for the last pay drawn by him in the scale of pay of District Judge and all allowances stipulated in Government order read as 2nd paper above less the amount of pension including dearness relief to which he is entitled to. In the meantime, as per the Government order read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above, the pay scale amenities and allowances of the Judicial officers were enhanced.

3) As per the judgement read as 4th paper above, the Hon'ble High Court have found that Sri.Muhammed Ibrahim is eligible to get the benefits in accordance with the Government order read as 3rd paper above as the Government order read as 2nd paper above(Ext P4) has been superseded by the Ext P5(G.O.(Ms) No.179/2010/Home dated 05-08-2010), and the same came into force on 01/01/2006. Hence it is directed by the Hon'ble High Court that Government shall pass fresh orders granting allowances to the petitioner in terms of Government order read as 3rd paper above within a period of 3

months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the Judgement.

4) Government have examined the matter in detail with reference to the findings in the judgement of the Hon'ble High Court and the existing orders in this regard. As per Rule 15(c) of Kerala Consumer Protection Rules, 2005, if the President, Consumer Disputes Redressal Forum is a retired District Judge, appointed on full time basis, he shall be eligible to obtain the last pay drawn in the scale of pay of the District Judge plus allowances attached there to, less the amount of pension including Dearness Relief to which he is entitled to or an honorarium of rupees 15,000 per month to whichever is higher. It is seen that G.O(Ms.)No 157/2006/Home dated 30/8/2006 has been superseded by G.O(Ms.)No 179/2010/Home dated 5/8/2010. In the above circumstances, after the date of superannuation, Sri.E. M.Muhammed Ibrahim, is eligible for the last pay drawn by him in the scale of pay of District Judge plus all allowances stipulated in G.O(Ms.)N o 179/2010/Home, dated 5/8/2010 less the amount of pension including Dearness Relief to which he is entitled to.

5) In the above circumstances Government are pleased to grant allowances to Sri.Muhammed Ibrahim as per the Government order read as 3<sup>rd</sup> above.

6) Judgement of the Hon'ble High Court read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper cited is thus complied with.


