ORDER

Government had accorded administrative sanction for the modernization and repair & maintenance of Sitaram Textiles Ltd for an amount of Rs.250 Lakh during 2021-22 as per the Government Order read as 1st paper above. During 2023-24, revised administrative sanction was accorded for Rs.130 Lakh as per the Government Order read as 2nd paper above. However no amount was released for the project during 2023-24. During 2024-25, an amount of Rs.108 Lakh was provided in the budget and Rs.37.80 Lakh was released, however the amount could not be utilized.

2. The Secretary, BPT as per letter read as 3rd above has requested to revalidate the administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.114 Lakh to Sitaram Textiles Ltd towards fund support for modernisation under the head of account 6860-01-190-97.

3. There is a Budget provision of Rs.114 Lakh for the year 2026-27 under the head of account 6860-01-190-97 for Mordernisation of Sitaram Textiles Ltd.

4. The Departmental Working Group Meeting of Industries Department held on 08.07.2026 considered the proposal and recommended for revalidation of the administrative sanction for modernisation of Sitaram Textiles for an amount of Rs.114 Lakh by meeting the expenditure from current year's budget provision under the H/A 6860-01-190-97 .

5. Government have examined the recommendation of the Working Group and are pleased to revalidate the Administrative Sanction for the modernisation and repair & maintenance of Sitaram Textiles Ltd for an amount of Rs.114 Lakh (Rupees One Hundred and Fourteen Lakh only) by meeting the expenditure from current year's budget provision under the H/A 6860-01-190-97 of Sitaram Textiles.
