ORDER

The Chief Engineer (IN&KP) as per letter cited 2nd above have forwarded a proposal for "Construction of fish landing center near fisheries school at Pandit Karuppan road, Thevara" for an amount of Rs.1.00 crore. It is reported in the estimate that a bund like formation emerged in Thevara due to the silt deposit and the fisheries activities in Vembanad lake is facing problems due to this silt deposit in the lake resulting the shortage of aquatic lives especially fishes. Hence, construction of a fish landing berth and desilt the nearby area for the landing of boats is necessary for supporting the fisher men community in this area.

2. In the state budget of the year 2025-26, the work "Construction of Thevara fish landing center for small fishing boats" is included as serial no.76 in the annexure to the detailed budget estimates (Work Appendix Vol - II) and allocated a token provision of Rs. 20.00 lakhs. As per the Government order cited 1st above, the implementing agency of the work is modified as Irrigation Department. The estimate is prepared based on DSR 2021 with prevailing cost index and the total estimated amount is Rs.1,00,00,000/- (One crore) including GST.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord administrative sanction for the work "Construction of fish landing center near fisheries school at Pandit Karuppan road, Thevara" for an amount of Rs. 1,00,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore only) under the h/a 5075-60-800-94-03-PV Inland Navigation (state sector)Direction and Administration-works,subject to the following conditions :

- i. The competent authority shall identify a suitable dumping yard for the dredged soil prior to awarding the contract. The initial level of the proposed dumping yard shall be recorded and reported to the CTE/ Finance (I & PW- B) department.
- ii. The competent authority shall ensure that the initial and final levels of the dredging work are recorded through a hydrographic survey and reported to CTE/ Finance (I & PW- B) department.
- iii. The soil investigation for identifying the properties of excavated material shall be conducted before issuing TS, and the estimate shall be modified accordingly for the proper disposal of dredged soil without causing loss to state exchequer.
- iv. The provisions provided in the estimate for the foundation of fish landing center shall be verified by TS authority before issuing the Technical Sanction and if required, the detailed soil investigation shall be done through Government approved agencies having good expertise in this area.
- v. The rate of CPVC pipe provided for bollard construction appears to be on the higher side. Hence, the TS authority shall examine the feasibility of adopting PVC pipes instead of CPVC pipes.
- vi. The correctness of the rates adopted for the observed data included in the TS estimate if any, shall be ensured by the TS authority.
- vii. The competent authority shall ensure the admissibility of provisions included in the estimate with the site conditions before issuing the Technical Sanction.

4. The Government order read 2nd above is hereby cancelled.
