As per the letter read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above, the Director of Medical Education has requested to allot the Central Share along with the corresponding State Share for the implementation of the project. As per the G.O read as 3<sup>rd</sup> paper above, Government have additionally authorised an amount of Rs.77,70,000/- under the HoA "2210-05-105-28-04 (PV) for the scheme.

2) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to release an amount of Rs.77,70,000/- (Rupees Seventy Seven Lakh Seventy Thousand only) (including Central Share for an amount of Rs.46,60,000/- and State Share for an amount of Rs.31,10,000/-) under the HoA "2210-05-105-28-04 (PV) for the procurement of equipment for the National Programme for Prevention and Management

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of Burn Injuries (NPPMBI)" at Govt. Medical College Thrissur.
