ORDER

As per Annual Plan 2025-26, a lump sum of Rs.31092.00 Lakh has been earmarked for Major Infrastructure Development Projects under the h/a 5475-00-115-99(P). This outlay is provided to facilitate the smooth and timely implementation of 10 major infrastructure development projects. The lump sum provision is controlled and operated by the Secretary, Planning and Economic Affairs Department.

As per the letter read as 2nd paper above, the Managing Director, Vizhinjam International Seaport Limited (VISL) submitted a proposal for an amount of Rs.6,13,92,500/- to meet administrative expenses, staff expenses, establishment expenses and consultancy expenses from the funds allotted to MIDP 2025-26 to the Company's PSTSB Account Number 7990-1270-0000-189 through the Head of Account 5051-01-001-99 via DDO code of Under Secretary (F&P)-0102 540 003.

The Fisheries & Ports Department has forwarded the proposal of VISL for placing before the High Powered Committee for consideration. The

meeting of the High Powered Committee for Major Infrastructure Development Projects (MIDP) 2025-26 held on 21.11.2025 chaired by the Additional Chief Secretary (Finance) examined the proposal and recommended to allocate Rs.6,13,92,500/- to meet administrative expenses, staff expenses, establishment expenses and consultancy expenses for the 2nd half of the financial year 2025-26 for Vizhinjam International Seaport Limited (VISL).

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to allocate an amount of Rs.6,13,92,500/- (Rupees Six Crore Thirteen Lakh Ninety Two Thousand and Five Hundred Only) to Vizhinjam International Seaport Limited (VISL) to meet administrative expenses, staff expenses, establishment expenses and consultancy expenses for the 2nd half of the financial year 2025-26.

The expenditure for the purpose shall be met from the h/a '5051-01-001-99 Development of Vizhinjam Deep Water International Transshipment Terminal (Plan) by deducting the same under the Lump head 5475-00-115-99 MIDP (Plan) during the financial year 2025-26.
