ORDER

As per the letter read above , the Transport Commissioner has furnished a proposal for according administrative sanction for the procurement of laptops to enhance infrastructure facilities for the conduct of Learner's Licence (LL) tests across Regional Transport Offices (RTOs) and Sub-Regional Transport Offices (SRTOs).

2) The requirement has been assessed as 294 laptops—three laptops for each SRTO (68 offices) and five laptops for each RTO (18 offices). The estimated unit cost is ₹50,000/-, and the total financial requirement comes to ₹1.50 Crore (rounded off). The expenditure is proposed to be met from the existing budget provision under the head of account 5055-00-800-90 – Implementation of E-Governance in MVD – Training and Capacity Building.

3) The Departmental Working Group meeting held on 02.06.2025 has approved the proposal.

4) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord administrative sanction for the procurement of 294 laptops (three laptops for each of the 68 Sub Regional Transport Offices and

five laptops for each of the 18 Regional Transport Offices) at a total cost of ₹1,50,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore and Fifty Lakh only). The expenditure shall be met from the head of account 5055-00-800-90 – Implementation of E-Governance in MVD – Training and Capacity Building, from the current financial year's budget provision, subject to the condition that the laptops shall be procured through the GeM portal.
