### Abstract

Public Works Department – Renovation of Panchayath Stadium, Kunnathukal – Revised Administrative Sanction – Accorded – Orders issued.

### ORDER

As per the Government Order read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above, Administrative Sanction was accorded for the work "Renovation of Panchayath Stadium, Kunnathukal" for an amount of ₹200.00 lakh (Rupees Two Hundred Lakh only) under the Head of Account 4059-01-051-86, subject to the condition that the Technical Sanction (TS) estimate shall be submitted to Government for concurrence before inviting tenders.

2. The Chief Engineer, Public Works (Buildings) Department as per letter read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above, has submitted the Technical Sanction Estimate to Government for concurrence for the above work. On examination of the TS estimate, it was observed that there is a

change in the scope of work, including the incorporation of additional components in the estimate.

**3.** Government after having examined the matter in detail and, in view of the changes in the scope of work reflected in the TS estimate, are pleased to accord Revised Administrative Sanction for the work "Renovation of Panchayath Stadium, Kunnathukal" for an amount of ₹200.00 lakh (Rupees Two Hundred Lakh only) under the Head of Account 4059-01-051-86, subject to the following conditions:

(i)The Chief Engineer, Public Works (Building Division) Department shall ensure that the works proposed in the estimate shall satisfy the functional requirements as envisaged along with adequate safety features.

(ii)The competent Technical Sanction authority shall ensure the change in scope of the work is essentially to be implemented at site.

(iii)Lump sum provision is provided for electrification; hence, detailed estimate shall be prepared before issuing TS.

(iv)The Chief Engineer, Public Works (Building Division) Department shall develop a comprehensive maintenance and operation plan for preserving the functionality of the ground and maintenance and upkeep including trash removal, if any etc and shall ensure adequate safety provisions.
