ORDER

Vide Government Order read as 1st paper above, the work 'Facilitation of Treatment Facilities in the New Five Storied Building at THQH Kodungallur' has been included under the Nava Kerala Sadas projects for an amount of Rs.2.30 crore. Accordingly the Director of Health Services, vide letter read as 2nd paper above, has submitted the proposal for the said work, prepared by M/s KEL. The Administrative Sanction Committee (H&FWD) for issuing Administrative Sanction for Nava Kerala Sadas Projects, constituted vide Government Order read as 3rd paper above examined the proposal on 24.12.2025 and decided to approve the same as detailed in the minutes read as 4th paper above.

2. Government have examined the matter in detail. Accordingly, Administrative Sanction is hereby accorded for the work 'Setting up of Male, female and Children's Ward at THQH Hospital Kodungallur' for an amount of Rs.2.30 crore, debiting the associated expenditure from H/a '4210- 01-110-74 - Construction Works under DHS', subject to the

following observations and conditions:

Observations

a) As per GO(P)No.104/2022/Fin dated 02.09.2022, M/s KEL has accreditation for executing Electro-Mechanical works and General Civil Construction works as PMC. In the present case, the estimate has been prepared by M/s KEL with rates inclusive of contractor's profit, indicating execution under PMC mode.

b) Although KEL has prepared the estimate for the purpose of AS proposal, the Director of Health Services is advised to select the accredited agency for execution of the work through a transparent and fair bidding process, as stipulated in Para 6 of GO(P)No.67/2021/Fin dated 28.04.2021, while executing the project.

Conditions

1. The Director of Health Services shall adhere to all government orders pertaining to the accredited agencies while executing the works through Government approved accredited agencies.
2. The Director of Health Services /TS authority shall ensure that competent and experienced Biomedical Engineers are appointed by the execution agency for vetting the estimate and for supervision of the execution of biomedical works.
3. TS authority shall ensure the correctness of the rates adopted for observed data provided in the estimate and the quality of materials during the time of execution.
4. The competent authority shall ensure the admissibility of provisions included in the estimate with the site conditions before issuing the Technical Sanction.
5. The work shall not exceed the estimate amount and no additional funds will be sanctioned for the same.
6. The Director of Health Services shall ensure that there is no overlapping of funds in the works.
