Due to his administrative efficiency, he has ensured efficient office functioning by minimising file pendency, processing files in Malayalam in accordance with State policy and ensuring the timely renewal of factory licences and thus contributed to improved revenue realisation and strengthened institutional credibility.

Ramesh Chandran, Inspector of Factories & Boilers Grade II, played a pivotal role in conceptualising, designing and coordinating Kerala first labour-centric digital Occupational Safety and Health (OSH) grievance redressal and complaint management system for factory workers and the general public benefitting over 7 lakh workers. As Project Nodal Officer, he made significant contribution for the projects Accident Prevention through Safety Surveillance (APSS) Project and the GIS-Based Factory Information Management System (K-SAFE). He has played a key role in institutional governance and capacity building as State Nodal and Coordinating Officer for the Kerala State Safety Award and for preparing India's first comprehensive 800-page State-level Occupational Safety and Health (OSH) Profile in formal collaboration with the International Labour Organization (ILO). He served as

State Coordinator for the NEBOSH Social Purpose Project enabling 44 Inspectors to acquire globally recognised OSH qualifications and establishing a sustainable cascade training model within the Department. He has also played a key role in the digitisation initiatives of Kerala State Agency for the Expansion of Cashew Cultivation (KSACC) particularly in the development of GIS (Geographic Information System) Mapping and Monitoring Project for cashew plantations across the State.
