### ORDER

As per the G.O read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above, Administrative Sanction was issued for the Centre of Excellence to Trauma & Burns unit Govt. Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram under "National Programme for Prevention and Management of Trauma and Burn Injuries (NPPMT & BI)", including an amount of Rs.78,50,000/- for the procurement of equipment. As per the letter read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above, the Director of Medical Education has informed that the KMSCL does not have the existing running contract for the procurement of equipment 'Fiberoptic Bronchoscope' and hence the DME has requested to accord permission to utilise the amount earmarked for the above equipment, for procuring the one unit of 'Portable Ventilator worth Rs.8,00,000/- and Essential Surgical Instruments for Causality worth Rs.4,73,000/-.'

2) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord **Revised Administrative Sanction** for an amount of **Rs.12,73,000/- (Rupees Twelve Lakh Seventy Three Thousand Only)** for the procurement of one unit of 'Portable Ventilator worth Rs.8,00,000/- and Essential Surgical Instruments for Causality worth Rs.4,73,000/-' instead of the equipment 'Fiberoptic Bronchoscope'

which was issued vide the G.O read above, for the "National Programme for Prevention and Management of Trauma and Burn Injuries (NPPMT & BI)" at Govt.Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram.
