ORDER

As per the Government order read as 1st paper above, Administrative Sanction has been accorded for conducting regional seminar, a project coming under the 100 days programme of Hon.Chief Minister, for an amount of Rs 1.5 lakhs under the component namely "Awareness Programmes" included in the Scheme "Strengthening State Land Use Board" for the FY 2024-25. As per the Government order read as 2nd paper above Administrative Sanction has been accorded for the purchase of departmental vehicle worth less than Rs.10 lakhs under the component namely "Water Resource Management and conservation plan for critical and semi critical blocks" included in the Scheme "Strengthening State Land Use Board" for the FY 2024-25. Thus, a total Administrative Sanction of Rs 11.50 Lakhs has been issued in the FY 2024-25 under the Scheme "Strengthening State Land Use Board" prior to the Chief Secretary Level Plan Prioritization meeting.

2. The Chief Secretary Level Committee meeting held on 05.11.2024, after taking into account the Government orders read as 1 & 2 paper above, has approved the plan proposals of the Kerala State Land Use Board for an amount of Rs 209 Lakhs as detailed below (including 87.19 Lakhs for the

Scheme Strengthening State Land Use Board) and recommended to issue Administrative Sanction for the components for an amount of Rs.197.5 Lakhs only, as Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs 11.50 Lakhs has already been issued in the current financial year.
