ORDER

As per Government Order read as 1st paper above, Administrative Sanction was accorded for an amount of Rs.3641.81 lakh for the project 'Construction of 200 bedded Cardiology Block at Government Medical College, Kottayam' under Tranche XXVI of NABARD RIDF scheme (NABARD share Rs.3095.56 lakh, State share 546.28 lakh). As per Government Order read as 2nd paper above, M/s. HITES was entrusted as the SPV for the project. As per Government Order read as 3rd paper above, Technical Sanction was issued for the above project for an amount of Rs.3025.66386 lakh.

2. The Director of Medical Education (DME) as per letter read as 4th paper above informed that M/s HITES has awarded the SITC of lift works in respect of project - Construction of 200 Bedded Cardiology Block at Government Medical College, Kottayam to M/s TK Elevators

for an amount of Rs.1,04,12,389/- (Excluding GST). The DME has also informed that now the PMC M/s HITES had submitted RAB 01 & part for the SITC of lift works and the same was forwarded to the Technical Committee (TC) for DME works and the Technical Committee has recommended to release an amount of Rs.70,28,363/- to the contractors. The DME has further pointed out that the Principal, GMC Kottayam has requested to release an amount of Rs.84,34,034/- including the GST for RAB 01 & Part. In view of the above, the DME has requested to allot an amount of Rs.84,34,034/- (including the GST) for releasing the payments for the lift works.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail. Accordingly sanction is hereby accorded to release an amount of **Rs.84,34,034/- (Rupees Eighty Four Lakh Thirty Four Thousand and Thirty Four Only)** to the Director of Medical Education on account of Reimbursement Claim for RAB 01 & part for the SITC of lift works (Including GST), for the project 'Construction of 200 Bedded Cardiology Block at Government Medical College, Kottayam' assisted by NABARD under RIDF XXVI, by debit to the head of account '**4210-03-105-12(01)-PV - Infrastructure Projects Under NABARD**', as detailed below :
