ORDER

As per the letter read above, the Director of Fisheries submitted a Project Proposal of Development of Regional Fisheries Technical High School, Koilandy, Kozhikode for a total outlay of Rs.399.00 lakhs and has requested to accord Administrative sanction for the same. The expenditure in this regard is proposed to be met from the Head of account 4405-00-103-93 (P) in the current financial year.

2) Existing Academic cum hostel building suffer from significant wear and tear, particularly in areas exposed to harsh environmental conditions. There's critical need to address damaged and corroded structural component like concrete frames in doors, windows, and ventilators, which pose both safety risks and functional limitations. This necessitates their replacement with more durable and secure alternatives. The objectives of the project are:

- **Improve the overall safety and structural integrity of the school infrastructure:** This includes ensuring all buildings (new and existing) meet safety standards, are structurally sound, and are resilient to environmental factors.
- **Enhance the functionality and usability of existing and new spaces:** Optimize layouts and features to better serve educational, administrative, and residential (hostel) needs.
- **Address and rectify all identified maintenance issues in existing buildings:** Eliminate deficiencies such as leaks, damaged fittings, and structural wear to restore optimal condition.
- **Ensure a consistent and adequate water supply for the entire school campus:** Implement solutions to resolve water scarcity issues.
- **Upgrade campus security and aesthetics:** Improve the external appearance and create a more secure environment for students and staff.
- **Provide modern, hygienic, and accessible sanitation facilities:** Construct or

renovate toilets to meet contemporary standards of hygiene and functionality.

- **Optimize space utilization by strategically adding new structures and demolishing obsolete ones:** Create necessary additional areas for activities while removing non-functional elements.

- **Ensure all fundamental operational and infrastructure needs of the school are comprehensively met:** This includes electrical, safety, and furnishing requirements to support daily activities effectively.
