ORDER

The Executive Chairman, Board for Public Sector Transformation as per the letter read as 3rd paper above has submitted a proposal for re-validation of the Administrative Sanction as per the G.O read as 1st paper above, for the completion of the validation the Non-betalctum plant and commercial production of LVP/SVP/Ophthalmic products for an amount of Rs.4.00 Crore during 2026-27, under the head of account of 6857-02-190-99(P). As per the revised Administrative Sanction for the project, the total project cost is Rs.58.87 Crore. In which, Rs.55.58 Crore will be provided by Government and Rs.3.29 Crore to be met by the company from internal resources. A total amount of Rs.50.06 Crores has been released from Government so far. Government accorded sanction to avail a bridge loan of Rs.5.00 crores from KSIDC subject to the condition that principal amount to be remitted up on release of the plan fund allocation. The project has entered the validation stage and trial runs of machinery have commenced

The Departmental working Group meeting held on 08/07/2026 considered the proposal and recommended to issue re-validation of Administrative Sanction of Rs.4.00 Crores to KSDP to complete the validation the Non-betalctum plant and commercial production of LVP/SVP/Ophthalmic products during 2026-27.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to re-validate the Administrative Sanction to KSDP to complete the validation of the Non-betalctum plant and commercial production of LVP/SVP/Ophthalmic products, for an amount of Rs.4.00 Crores, during 2026-27, subject to the following conditions

- All rules, formalities and procedures in force shall be strictly followed for the implementation of the project.
- The expenditure would be met from the provision available under the appropriate head of account. The expenditure shall be limited to the current year's budget provision.
- The fund release will be based on actual requirement and the fund released should not be parked in banks.
- Stores Purchase Rules shall be strictly adhered to wherever applicable.
- Tender/e-tender and other stipulated formalities shall be followed wherever necessary.
- Post creation and purchase of vehicles are not admissible under the scheme.
- For hiring of project staff / manpower as part of project implementation, instructions issued in G.O.(P)No.76/2019/Fin dated 02.07.2019 and G.O.(P)No.81/2019/Fin dated 09.07.2019 shall be followed.
- All works and purchases connected with the Project shall be arranged through transparent bidding using the e- tender portal of Government.

4. The Managing Director, Kerala State Drugs and Pharmaceuticals Ltd shall implement the project.
