#### **ORDER**

In the Annual Plan Budget for 2025-26, an amount of Rs.1200 Lakh has been provided under the Head of Account '2210-06-101-49 (Plan)' (Rs.396.95 Lakh under 24 M&S and Rs.803.05 Lakh under 34 OC) for the implementation of the plan scheme 'Surveillance and Control of Communicable Diseases'. As per the letter read above, the Director of Health Services submitted Annual Plan Scheme proposal seeking Administrative Sanction for implementing the above scheme for an amount of Rs.10,66,15,417/- (Rs.3,70,79,062/- under 24 M&S and Rs.6,95,36,355/- under 34 OC) by meeting the expenditure under the above head of account from the current year's budget provision.

- 2. The Departmental Working Group Meeting for Health & Family Welfare Department held on 19.06.2025 scrutinised the above mentioned plan scheme proposal submitted by the Director of Health Services and approved the proposal as detailed in the minutes read above.
- 3. Government have examined the matter in detail. Accordingly, in pursuance of the decision of the Departmental Working Group, Administrative Sanction is accorded for the implementation of the scheme 'Surveillance and Control of Communicable Diseases' at a

total cost of Rs.10,66,15,417/- (Rupees Ten Crore Sixty Six Lakh Fifteen Thousand Four Hundred and Seventeen only) by meeting the expenditure from the provision under the head of account '2210-06-101-49 (Plan)', as provided in the FY 2025-26, as detailed below;
