ORDER

As per the Government Order read as 1st paper above, Government have accorded administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.73,80,000/- for the completion of ERSS Project under the head of account 2055-00-001-88-00-00-P-V. As per the letter read as 2nd paper above, the State Police Chief has informed that proceedings also issued from PHQ by which sanction has been accorded to transfer an amount of Rs.66,08,932/- as the committed expenditure due to C-DAC, directly to their Bank Account, considering the specific direction from Ministry of Home Affairs. Accordingly Rs.66,08,932/- was released to C-DAC towards work done by them for the implementation of ERSS project and transfer of District Co-ordination Centre, Thiruvananthapuram City.

2) Subsequently, the State Police Chief has also informed that there was an unspent balance of Rs.7,71,068/- under the scheme. In the meantime, MHA has directed that the unspent amount and the interest earned on the unspent amount has to be deposited in the Consolidated Fund of India. The

State Police Chief has further reported that since essential requirement proposals for UPS, Computer Monitor, Computer Table, Headset for Call takers, Revolving Chairs and Electric and Electronic items etc. have been received from unit heads, the said essential items were procured for an amount of Rs.7,70,975/- for the smooth and effective functioning of ERSS Control Rooms/Centre by utilizing this unspent balance.

3) The State Police Chief has therefore requested to ratify the action in having expended Rs.7,70,975/- without obtaining sanction from the Government and action of purchased various essential items for the smooth functioning of ERSS Control Rooms/Centre within the authorized amount.

4) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to ratify the action of the State Police Chief in having expended Rs.7,70,975/- (Rupees Seven Lakh Seventy Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy Five Only) without obtaining prior Government sanction and the action of purchased various essential items for the smooth functioning of ERSS Control Rooms/Centre within the authorized amount.
