<u>ORDER</u>

The Chief Executive Officer, Infopark, Kochi has submitted proposals for implementing the schemes **'Infrastructure Works in Phase I, Koratty & Cherthala, Phase II LAR and Marketing Activities'** for according Administrative Sanction for an amount of ₹2170 Lakh (Rupees Two Thousand One Hundred and Seventy Lakh only). The Departmental Working Group meetings of Electronics & Information Technology Department held on 17.04.2024 and 27.06.2024 approved the schemes and recommended to issue Administrative Sanction for implementation of the schemes.

4) The following conditions should be adhered to while implementing the schemes.

1. Estimate for civil works to be prepared in PRICE software.

2.In the case of Marketing, the selection of agency should be through transparent procedure.

3. LAR Awards are to be passed after exploring the scope of filing appeal in each case.

4. In all projects, whose manpower component is involved, before paying salary, Head of Institutions should ensure that all those posts are continuing with the specific approval of Government.

5. If appointment of new personnel or purchase of vehicles is involved, prior approval of Government should be taken.

6. Expenditure should be limited to the current year's budget provision.

7. The expenditure shall be met from the provision available under the appropriate Head of Account.

8. Fund release will be based on actual requirement and the fund released should not be parked in banks.

9. Store purchase rules should be strictly adhered to.

10. Tender/ e-tender and other stipulated formalities shall be followed.

5) The Chief Executive Officer, Infopark shall follow all the prescribed guidelines, rules, other formalities and procedures for implementation of the scheme. Proposals for release of funds should contain break up of expenditure, report on the component wise expenditure of funds released during the previous year and component wise Utilization Certificates in the prescribed proforma. Funds will not be released in case of any procedural laxity or violation.
