ORDER

As per the letter read as 2nd paper above, the Ministry of Home Affairs, Women Safety Division, Government of India, has released an amount of **₹15.67625 lakh** to the Government of Kerala for *setting up and strengthening of Women Help Desks in Police Stations under the Nirbhaya Fund* for the financial year 2025-26. Out of this, **₹1,67,625/-** represents the balance amount resumed by the Ministry of Home Affairs on 31.03.2024 from the sanctioned amount of ₹ 250 lakh for 2021-22, for which administrative sanction had already been issued vide order read as 1st paper above.

The State Police Chief, as per the letter read as 3rd paper above, has

requested that administrative sanction be accorded for an amount of **₹14 lakh** (i.e., ₹15,67,625 – ₹1,67,625) for implementing Women Help Desks in **14 Police Stations/Police Offices** in the State at the rate of ₹1 lakh per station/office under the Nirbhaya Fund Scheme 2025-26, so as to ensure utilisation of the funds within the current financial year.

Government, after examining the matter in detail, are pleased to accord **administrative sanction for an amount of ₹14 lakh** for setting up Women Help Desks in Police Stations, at the rate of ₹1 lakh per station, debiting the expenditure to the Head of Account **2055-00-109-90-PV**, subject to observance of all procedural formalities and strict adherence to the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs.
