As per the letter read as 2^{nd} paper above, the Ministry of Home Affairs, Women Safety Division, Government of India, has released an amount of **₹15.67625 lakh** to the Government of Kerala for *setting up and strengthening of Women Help Desks in Police Stations under the Nirbhaya Fund* for the financial year 2025-26. Out of this, **₹1,67,625**/represents the balance amount resumed by the Ministry of Home Affairs on 31.03.2024 from the sanctioned amount of ₹250 lakh for 2021-22, for which administrative sanction had already been issued vide order read as 1^{st} paper above.

The State Police Chief, as per the letter read as 3rd paper above, has

requested that administrative sanction be accorded for an amount of $\mathbb{T}14$ lakh (i.e., $\mathbb{T}15,67,625 - \mathbb{T}1,67,625$) for implementing Women Help Desks in 14 Police Stations/Police Offices in the State at the rate of $\mathbb{T}1$ lakh per station/office under the Nirbhaya Fund Scheme 2025-26, so as to ensure utilisation of the funds within the current financial year.

Government, after examining the matter in detail, are pleased to accord administrative sanction for an amount of ₹14 lakh for setting up Women Help Desks in Police Stations, at the rate of ₹1 lakh per station, debiting the expenditure to the Head of Account 2055-00-109-90-PV, subject to observance of all procedural formalities and strict adherence to the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs.
