<u>ORDER</u>

Computerization of Revenue Department is key to the speedy and effective delivery of quality services thereby ensuring transparency in revenue administration. Manipulation of sensitive data can be controlled to a great extent by adopting strict logical protocols. The development of a web portal encompassing all revenue services and payments under a single umbrella - the revenue portal - with a single login facility is of prime importance. As part of modernization, Revenue Department is to utilize information technology for better delivery of citizen services in a faster, efficient and transparent manner. Hence an amount of Rs. 2650 lakh has been provided under the head of account '5475-00-800-77-02' during the current financial year.

2] The Commissioner, Land Revenue, as per the letter read as 1st paper above, has furnished a proposal for the scheme 'Computerization of Revenue Department' for according administrative sanction.

3] The Special Working Group meeting held on 12.06.2025 considered the proposal and approved the same subject to the condition that comprehensive administrative sanction should be issued for the scheme.

4] In the circumstances, the Government are pleased to accord administrative sanction for the proposal 'Computerization of Revenue Department', furnished by the Commissioner, Land Revenue, amounting to Rs. 2650 lakh (Two thousand Six Hundred and Fifty lakh only) for the components as detailed below:
