ORDER

As per the Government order read as 1st paper above, Administrative Sanction was accorded for the implementation of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme - Component 1 (City -level action) of the CITIIS 2.0 Program in Thiruvananthapuram City for the object of "Improved & integrated Solid Waste Management in the City of Thiruvananthapuram" and authorised Smart City Thiruvananthapuram Ltd (SCTL) as the Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) for an implementation period of four years, adhering to the CITIIS 2.0 Component 1 Operational Guidelines. Since this scheme was notified under the SNA-SPARSH mechanism, the new accounting platform operated through RBI, Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs, Government of India have released first tranche of Mother sanction for an amount of Rs 87,00,000/- (Eighty seven lakh rupees) towards the central share as per reference read as 2nd paper above.

(2) As per the Quadrilateral Agreement dated 03.03.2025, executed between the Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs, Government of Kerala, Smart City Thiruvananthapuram Limited and Thiruvananthapuram Municipal Corporation, 20% of the project fund shall be borne by the State/ULB. As per letter read as 3rd paper above, the Chief Executive Officer, Smart City Thiruvananthapuram Ltd has requested for the release of the Mother Sanction amount of 87 lakh allotted by the Government of India.

(3) As per letter read as 4th paper above, Finance Officer, Smart City Thiruvananthapuram Ltd informed that the Mother Sanction has been modified to Rs.55 lakh in consideration of the probability to spend during this year and requested to release the modified amount of Mother Sanction of Rs.55,00,000 (Fifty five lakh rupees) along with corresponding State Share (20%).

(4) Government have examined the matter in detail. Under the SNA SPARSH accounting mechanism, bills for SNA SPARSH shall be prepared and drawn through the State Head of account [2217-05-191-48 (52) & 2217-05-191-48 (53)] of corresponding State linked Scheme having both Central and State shares. Sanction is therefore accorded for the release of an amount of Rs.68,75,000/- (Rupees Sixty eight lakh seventy-five Thousand only) which includes Rs.55,00,000/- being the amount of modified Mother Sanction towards Central Share and Rs.13,75,000/- towards the corresponding 20% matching State Share for Component 1 of the CSS-CITIIS 2.0. The Chief Executive Officer, Smart City Thiruvananthapuram Limited who is the DDO shall take necessary steps to present bills to incur expenditure from the available provision under the Head of Account 2217-05-191-48 (53) State Share (Plan) for the CSS provided in the annual budget 2025-26.

(5) The Chief Executive Officer, Smart City Thiruvananthapuram Limited shall also follow instructions in Circular No. 02/2025/Fin. dated 10.01.2025 and the decisions as per the Minutes of the meeting held on 26.11.2024 to onboard the scheme "KL387 - CITIIS 2.0 THIRUVANANTHAPURAM Component 1 (80:20 CSS)" to SNA SPARSH. He shall also ensure that the utilization from the additional funds authorised under the SNA-SPARSH heads of account is limited to the actual requirement w.r.t. the Mother Sanction received for the scheme.
