Read:- Letter No. C5-187288/2025/PHQ dated 20.12.2025 & C5-45625/2026/PHQ dated 17.03.2026 received from the State Police Chief, Kerala.

ORDER

The State Police Chief as per the letter read above has informed that a hotline connection was established between the District Police Command & Control Room, Aluva and the Security Operational Control Centre, CISF, Cochin International Airport Limited, Nedumbassery, in connection with a military campaign code named 'Operation Sindoor' in May 2025. As it was observed that the existing channels of communication were inadequate to ensure rapid coordination in emergent situations and as delays in information flow could adversely affect the preparedness and response capability of district police units, a hotline connection was established without procedural delay. It is informed that an amount of Rs.5,664/- has been incurred towards the installation charge for purchasing modem and cable for the above action and also a sum of Rs.3,141/- is pending as telephone charges at the end of September 2025.

2) Therefore the State Police Chief has requested to ratify the above action taken in anticipation of Government sanction and to grant permission

to continue the connection in view of the possibility of any similar situation in future and requested to accord sanction for disbursing the amount.

3) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to ratify the action of the State Police Chief and to make a payment of Rs.8,805/- (Rupees Eight Thousand Eight Hundred and Five Only) from the head of account "2055-00-109-99-00-05-03-NV" since the hotline connection was taken to address a security urgency, subject to the condition that no further expenditure will be incurred in this regard.
